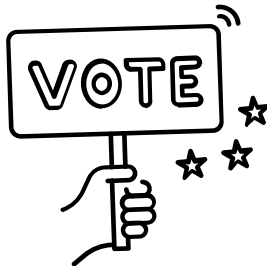
What's at stake?
