



VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES TO ELECT DEMOCRATS 2022

NEIGHBORHOOD AND PRECINCT OPPORTUNITIES:

1. **PRECINCT CHAIR** – Elected/Appointed office; responsible for identifying Democrat residents, canvassing Dem residents each election, distributing literature on candidates and issues, and encouraging all Dem residents to VOTE.
2. **PRECINCT CO-ORDINATOR:** Appointed office; Assists Precinct Chair throughout entire precinct, as needed.
3. **BLOCK CAPTAIN** – Trained Volunteer position; focuses on their own block or neighborhood Dem residents to GOTV, through phone/text banks, block walking, etc. Works with their nearby neighbors.

SINGLE TASKS: To recruit volunteers, promote a candidate, register voters, and encourage Democrat residents to VOTE, etc., etc.

These are the most popular ways to volunteer:

- **PHONE BANKS** – Call through computer from your home or BCDP HQ
- **TEXTING BANKS** – Through your computer or phone
- **BLOCK WALKING** – Knock on doors to ID Dem voters, distribute campaign materials, promote a candidate, recruit volunteers, encourage Dems to VOTE, etc.
- **REGISTER VOTERS** – Become a VDR (Deputy Voter Registrar)
- **BCDP HQ OFFICE** – Assist with office visitors and callers, assist with events, etc.
- **DEMOCRATIC CLUBS** -Many opportunities to volunteer with the various Bexar County Democratic clubs and organizations, such as Bexar Co. Young Democrats, NE Bexar Co. Democrats, NW Bexar Co. Democrats, Stonewall Democrats, etc
